

KRABI PROVINCIAL ORDER

Upgrading of Domestic Travel measures for entering Krabi according to the prevention and control measure for Coronavirus Disease 2019

- For those who are from red zone province and driving pass through Krabi province without staying overnight, it is mandatory to present the papers showing the necessary of travelling across the province from the departure province.
- The red zone provinces are Bangkok, Kanchanaburi, Chonburi, Chachoengsao, Tak, Nakhonpathom, Nakornnayok, Nakornsratchasrima, Narathiwat, Nonthaburi, Prathumthani, Prajuabkirikhan, Prachinburi, Pattani, Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya, Phetburi, Phetchaboon, Yala, Rayong, Ratchaburi, Lobburi, Songkla, Singburi, Samutprakarn, Samutsongkram, Samutsakhorn, Saraburi, Suphanburi and Ang-Thong.
- For those who are not from red zone province and driving pass though Krabi province without staying overnight, or for those who are recently recovered from the sickness of Coronavirus Diseases less than 90 days or for those who travel with necessary purposes, it is mandatory to present the identification card or governmental identification card and the notification letter mentioning about the necessary reason to travel across the province.
- To enter Krabi province, it is mandatory to have the confirmation letter that the traveler is vaccinated, based on the requirement by Ministry of Health or Astrazeneka for at least of one dose, longer than 14 days.
- It is mandatory to have the confirmation letter of RT-PCR or Rapid Antigen Test, at least of 7 days before travelling.
- Except for those who is aged less than 18 years old and they are not entitled to be vaccinated, then it is mandatory to have the confirmation letter of RT-PCR or Rapid Antigen Test, at least of 7 days before travelling.
- For kids aged less than 5 years old, it is not mandatory to have the confirmation letter of RT-PCR or Rapid Antigen Test but it is required to register through QT14 and download Mor ChaNa application in order to keep following and tracking the journey.
- The condition of gathering is not more than 50 people and it is mandatory to follow the rules and regulations of Ministry of Health strictly.
- Prohibit organizing the party, celebration or any kind of entertainment event.
